This I-Day course covers the content of the Level I course but also expands on the effects of drugs and alcohol, incorporates the First Aid for Mental Health Action Plan and covers ways in which a positive mental health culture can be supported within a workplace.

Duration

A minimum of 6 hours spread over at least one day. Ideally, the course should be run in one day, but must be completed within 3 weeks of starting the course, with each training session a minimum of two hours.

Syllabus

A range of First Aid for Mental Health related subjects are covered including:

- What is First Aid for Mental Health?
- Identifying mental health conditions
- Providing advice and starting a conversation
- Stress
- Mental health conditions
- Drugs and alcohol
- First Aid for Mental Health action plan
- First Aid for Mental Health in the workplace

Numbers

A maximum of 16 students are allowed on the course and must be a minimum of 18 years of age. A certificate can be offered to all,

subject to assessment.

Assessment

A range of methods are used, including practical and questioning (open and multiple-choice).

Certification

Upon successful completion of the qualification assessment, delegates will be awarded a Quay Medical/Mental Health at Sea Seafarers First Aid for Mental Health Training Course 'Certificate of Attendance'. Delegates will also be awarded the Ofqual regulated Level 2 Award in First Aid for Mental Health (RQF)/Award in First Aid for Mental Health at SCQF Level 5. This qualification is valid for three years from the date of achievement. It is strongly recommended that the learner attends annual refresher training. The learner will need to complete the full 'Ofqual' course again to requalify for a further three years.

Venues

Ideally, this course should be delivered in a collective group environment on board a vessel or a shore based venue as a team. However, other appropriate venues and permutations can be facilitated by us.
